Our 21 or more scholarships are designed to recognize students who demonstrate determination, leadership, community involvement, and a commitment to their future goals. We believe that every student deserves the opportunity to continue their education, and we are honored to help make that possible. There are two categories to apply:

Category A: If you are a graduating high school senior planning to attend a college, university, or vocational program, we encourage you to apply by visiting www.comerciantesunidos.org.

For this category, the requirements are:

- Currently enrolled in 12th grade and have been accepted to a community college or university.
- Residents of San Joaquin County.
- Be the child of Hispanic parents (at least one).
- Hold a minimum Grade Point Average (GPA) of 3.0.
- Write an essay in Spanish or English (minimum one page) on the topic: "Why Do I Deserve This Scholarship?"
- Provide a letter of recommendation from a teacher or school counselor.
- Submit your most recent academic records (known as "Transcripts" in English).

Category B: If you are registered as a "Dreamer Student" at San Joaquin Delta College, you could qualify for a scholarship. Please contact the Dream Success Center at (209) 954-5731.

Selected recipients will receive their award at the 2026 Scholarship Awards Ceremony on Friday, June 26, 2026, at the San Joaquin Delta College's Campesino Forum, where families, educators, and community leaders gather to celebrate your achievements.

To apply, please complete the scholarship application and submit all required documents by Sunday May 31, 2026. We encourage you to take this step — your hard work, your story, and your aspirations matter.
